SENIOR SCHOOL

Our Senior School offers a worldclass education alongside a host of life-shaping experiences unique to our alpine environment.

YEARS 5 - 6 PREP FORM AGES 9 - 10

Aiglon's bespoke programme for our youngest students ensure they are given everything they need to succeed during their years at Aiglon. Small class sizes support all the standards found in the UK's Key Stage 1 and 2 curriculum.

YEARS 7 - 9 DISCOVERY YEARS AGES 11 - 13

The Aiglon journey takes a life of its own in the three-strand Discovery Programme: a unified curricular approach, amazing trips and hands-on learning ensure those entering Senior School are more than prepared for what's next.

YEARS 10 - 11 EXPLORATION YEARS AGES 14 - 15

In Senior School, Years 10 and 11 follow the IGCSE programme or our bespoke Pre-IB course if joining in Year 11. This prepares students from all backgrounds for the rigour of the IB. In 2022, 59% of Aiglon students received A*/A grades and 88% A*-B.

YEARS 12 - 13 DIPLOMA YEARS AGES 16 - 18

To graduate, Aiglon's final two years are more than just the IB. Students define their path to success focusing on academic excellence and extensive co-curricular enrichment. The IB at Aiglon is like no other meeting the needs of highly motivated students – with amazing results.

UNDERSTANDING THE IB AT AIGLON

6 SUBJECTS (3 HIGHER, 3 STANDARD)

Aiglon offers a total of over 60 IB subjects.

Languages: Arabic, English, French, German, Japanese, Mandarin, Russian, Spanish. Sciences: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Systems, Computer Science. Maths: Analysis and Approaches, Applications and Interpretation. Individuals & Societies: Business Management, Economics, Geography, History, Psychology. Arts: Music, Theatre Arts, Visual Arts.

EXTENDED ESSAY & THEORY OF KNOWLEDGE (TOK)

Supported by their tutor and IB team, students develop their 4,000 word research essay in line with IB standards while drawing on unique Aiglon experiences. The TOK component is enhanced through handson learning, small classes and a dedicated European TOK trip.

CREATIVITY, ACTIVITY, SERVICE PORTFOLIO

The CAS portfolio is central to the IB's well-rounded curricular approach; Aiglon students participate and reflect on their experiences with a unique perspective thanks to Aiglon's holistic environment.




8 SENIOR BOARDING HOUSES
