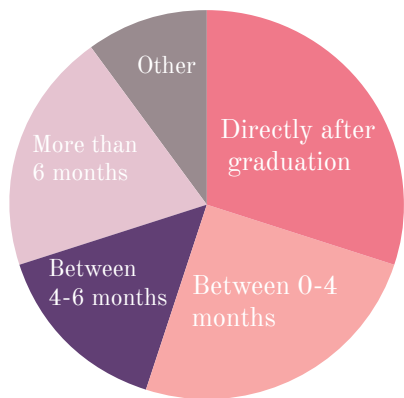

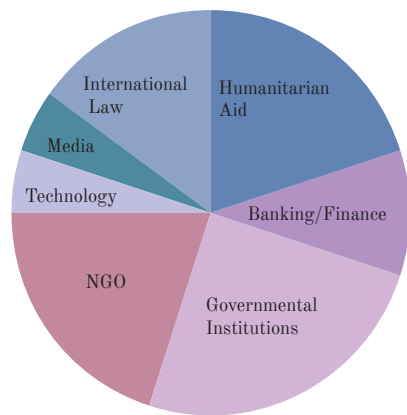

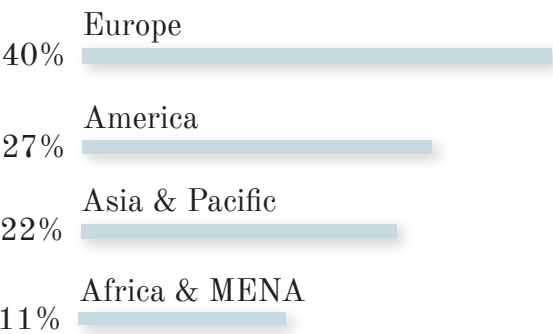
How long a student takes to find a job after graduation
