




BACHELOR'S DEGREES

- Recommendation letter from a teacher or school counsellor;
- Certified English translations of all academic documents not issued in English; and
- Copy of valid passport.

- Original essay in English with a min. of 600 words on a program-related topic;
- Recommendation letter from professor or work supervisor;
- certified English translations of all academic documents not issued in English;
- CV showing work experience; and
- Copy of valid passport.
