

Suitable for ages 13 - 18 with CEFR proficiency level of A2 - B1/2. Students at B2 should consider another academic (for instance Debate or Study Skills) and those at C1/2 level will be too advanced for this class.

The English Language programme at ISSOS is designed for those who have English as a second language.

At ISSOS learning English is about more than studying words and phrases – we offer our students the chance to explore new ideas and cultures and develop communication skills that will open doors across the globe. This exciting interactive programme caters for all ability levels and helps students to become proficient in the English language by immersing them in an Englishspeaking environment.



Study Skills


We also work with students to manage exam and academic stress and teach them coping techniques for dealing with the increased workload that they may be facing at this stage of their high school career.

IB Extended Essay

Students taking this class must be writing their Essay in English, and must arrive with an Essay topic already approved by their school.

This programme is designed to offer all students currently working towards their IB extended essay the chance to combine interactive seminars and in-depth individual research with personal attention from highly qualified mentors.

The interactive skills seminars are designed to equip students with the know-how, skills, experience and confidence necessary to achieve their personal best as well as to pave the way for success in higher education.


Seminar topics and exercises will cover a wide variety of essential skills such as:

- Essay writing (including research techniques, outlining and structuring an argument, editing and formatting)
- Oral presentations and public speaking
- Independent study
- Time management and organisation

Supervised individual research periods are designed to help students put these skills into action and to make significant progress on the Extended Essay and/or other course work of their choice. Held in the renowned Main Library of the University of St Andrews, these research and study periods provide students with:

- Qualified supervisors and mentors to help students access the materials they require

Business and Entrepreneurship

Suitable for ages 13 - 18 with CEFR English level B1 and above.

At ISSOS we look to prepare students for the future by giving them the skills, confidence and motivation to succeed in life beyond the classroom. Over three weeks our Business and Entrepreneurship programme will introduce students to a world beyond academia, through a series of interactive workshops, practical tasks and case studies. Students will learn about some of the most successful businesses in the world and understand what makes them work.

Students will learn about what it takes to be an entrepreneur and the fundamentals of starting a business and marketing a product. In small groups students will generate ideas for businesses or products and will present these ideas to a panel. In addition, students will research how to market their product and generate interest.

Academic Programmes

As well as learning to write a business plan students will investigate the inner workings of a successful company: how a business operates, how to build a successful team and the leadership qualities of effective managers and leaders.

Students are challenged to further develop their interpersonal and leadership skills through an enhanced curriculum that includes:

- Marketing of a product and or business

This unique programme introduces students to the world of enterprise and helps students in the classroom and beyond by building their confidence, developing their communication skills and engaging their imagination to discover their passion for business and the opportunities that surround them.

Creative Writing

Suitable for ages 14 - 18 with CEFR English level B2 and above.

Our bespoke Creative Writing programme is designed for students of all levels and interests who have a desire to explore their own potential and challenge themselves creatively.

Introductory and advanced workshops will introduce students to all phases of the writing process, including generating ideas, writing and revising drafts and editing.

- Discover writing through a range of creative projects including essays, short stories and poetry
- Learn the necessary tools and strategies to discover your own voice
- Study the work of individuals and find out how to use the world around you as a source of ideas and inspiration
- Benefit from regular writing practice and balanced critical evaluation
- See your work in print by contributing to the publication - The ISSOS Times

Students write extensively and the course is intended for those who want to understand and harness the forces of creative language to produce original poems, scenes from a play or movie and short stories.

Students are encouraged to submit written pieces to the ISSOS Times and set up a creative blog to share written work of their choice with a wider community.

Academic Programmes





Journalism

Cambridge

Suitable for ages 13 - 18 with CEFR English level B2 and above.

Students at ISSOS who choose our journalism course will be taught to sharpen their research and writing skills and debate social, political and ethical issues. These skills have wide-ranging applications and will stand students in good stead during their education and beyond.

Students will return home with a stronger foundation of journalistic skills and values, and will be equipped with the techniques for writing and editing copy. The course combines inspirational seminars and practical workshops with individual and group exercises:

- Enhance your essay writing skills and learn to structure an argument
- Undertake practical assignments; compile a news report, research and write a feature article or interview a person of interest

- Learn the techniques for editing copy and designing pages for publication
- Use the power of language to communicate effectively and inspire others

Students will investigate current affairs, practice the core journalism skills of interviewing and research and learn to write inspiring and accurate articles on their choice of topic.

As a team, the students on this course will assist in the production of The ISSOS Times, the summer school's newspaper. In addition students will publish their articles weekly on our online journalism blog.

Youth Leadership

Suitable for ages 13 - 18 with CEFR English level B1 and above.

At ISSOS we believe that each student deserves to discover their potential and acquire the skills, confidence and motivation to bring about change.

Over three weeks, our Youth Leadership programme will give students the unique opportunity to take part in a series of interactive workshops, energetic activities and fun-filled challenges. These are specifically designed to inspire and enable each and every student to uncover their unique abilities, develop greater confidence and master strategies for success in the classroom and beyond.

Rather than focusing on any specific school curriculum, this programme will offer handson learning, leadership and interpersonal skills, enabling all students, regardless of background, experience or ability level, to get ahead. We want to help students eliminate school stress, while at the same time showing them ways to express themselves, pursue goals, solve problems, resolve conflicts and bring about positive change.

Tennis

Students at ISSOS will have the opportunity to work with our professional tennis coaches to learn new skills, achieve their personal goals and develop a love of the game. The course is designed to meet the needs of every student, whether a complete beginner or an advanced level tennis player.

- Develop fundamental skills to improve your game

Beginners will benefit from individual attention and constant encouragement, as well as being taught the skills to develop their basic tennis strokes. Intermediate players will refine their strokes and will learn how to use their strengths to give them an advantage every time they walk on the court. More advanced players also cover spin techniques, positional play, footwork and tactical awareness.

All players have the opportunity to play full-length games and to learn the rules of the game as well as good tennis technique, sportsmanship and general fitness.

This three-week elective will culminate in the ISSOS Tennis tournament, in which all students are invited to participate.



Film



Our three-week film elective gives students the unique opportunity to discover the fascinating world of filmmaking and to let their imaginations run free. The course provides a practical introduction to all aspects of film craft through a combination of interactive seminars, technical training and hands-on experience behind the camera. Armed with this knowledge, students will then create their very own short films to be screened in front of the entire Summer School.

- Immerse yourself in the process of film-making
- · Learn to use industry standard equipment
- Benefit from professional guidance and instruction
- Develop your teamwork and leadership skills as you embark on your own projects
- Discover the excitement and satisfaction of seeing your ideas come to life

Throughout this course, students of all ability levels will benefit from expert tuition on script writing, directing, production management, cinematography and editing, right through to location scouting and set design. Each student will receive instruction in the use of industry standard cameras and editing software. Working in small teams, students will then learn to work within a production crew taking turns to direct, produce and create their own unique films.

This elective has been designed to give students a practical introduction to film-making, while at the same time, helping them to appreciate the rewards of teamwork and the satisfaction of putting their own ideas into action. Students will not only create their own unique films, they will also gain the confidence to express and discuss their ideas, learn what it takes to put their ideas into action and discover the rewards of seeing their ideas come to life on the big screen.



Cambridge Yale


This unique course will develop students' confidence and personal leadership abilities through varied and exciting outdoor activities.

The imaginative and inspirational theatre course gives students the opportunity to explore and extend their theatrical skills and devise a unique piece of theatre.


Over the three-week period this elective course will combine a series of skill-based masterclasses and ensemble workshops in which students will work as a team under the guidance of a theatre professional to create an exciting piece of original theatre, which will be performed in the final week.

This course has been designed specially by theatrical professionals to enthuse all students with a keen interest in the performing arts regardless of previous experience. The combination of classes and ensemble workshops will help students develop a wide variety of skills relating to voice and movement including story-telling, mime and improvisation, as well as giving them experience of ensemble based and devised theatre. Participants will also be offered the opportunity to learn and assist with directing, production and lighting.

The advantages of the relaxed and stimulating environment we offer at ISSOS are clear in the work that is produced by the students during their stay. To acknowledge their achievements, work is put on display in a final week art exhibition for all to admire.





Evening Programmesand Activities

In addition to cultural trips, every evening students take part in a full summer school evening programme. These are designed to cater to everyone and range from sporting activities to creative pursuits and include: Dodgeball, Ultimate Frisbee, Urban Orienteering, Mini Olympics, Variety Show, Guest Speakers Debate, Scottish country Dancing, Movie Night, Disco and many more.

As well as evening programmes all students are offered the option of taking part in activities after elective classes have finished, these are optional and are based on what students show an interest in from sport to creativity. With such a varied selection of activities on offer, we are confident that each and every student will enjoy this aspect of the ISSOS experience.

Weekend Workshops

Students will also have the opportunity to choose from a variety of Sunday workshops – fun additions to the weekly programme that provide our students with the chance to try their hand at something different. Whether this involves handball, volleyball on the beach, learning to write a comedy sketch, or honing skills in still photography, our action-packed Sunday programme offers activities to suit every taste.

Cultural Trips

Over the course of the three weeks all students will experience the best of what each location has to offer in an incredibly varied day trip programme. Students will have the opportunity to discover the surrounding cities and historic landmarks that make each location unique. As a sample of the trips that are available to students:

St Andrews

Edinburgh, Scotland's capital and Glasgow, Europe's No. 1 shopping city, as well as some of Scotland's most beautiful castles and cultural sites.

Cambridge

Oxford, one of England's most famous university cities and Windsor, the historical town and castle. Students will also visit some of England's best palaces and museums.

Yale

New York and Boston, two of America's most famous and exciting cities, where students will be given options to explore the parts of the city of most interest to them. In addition students will benefit from visits to museums, the Connecticut Science Centre and local cultural sites.

















At ISSOS one of our main aims is to make sure students are safe and have the best experience possible by making friends from all over the world and by being involved in everything ISSOS has to offer. One of the many ways that we achieve this is with the way in which we are structured. At ISSOS students become part of an ever growing international family and while at the summer school are split in to groups and clans that are integral to the ISSOS experience.

Groups

When students arrive at ISSOS they will have been pre-assigned to a group that is headed up by an ISSOS counselor. The groups are divided up between male and female and are assigned based on age. There are normally 8–12 students in a group and they stay in the same area of halls and their counselor is there to make sure they are safe and happy at all times. Each group is named after a Scottish island or river and students form close bonds.



Clans

At ISSOS we like to celebrate our Scottish roots, as a result the ISSOS clan system has become a central part of the student experience. ISSOS has four student clans: MacDonald, Stewart, MacGregor and Wallace and one staff clan; Munro. Each clan is represented by a different colour and students are given a clan t-shirt when they are welcomed into a clan at an Evening Programme called Clan Calling.

Brothers and sisters of alumni will be welcomed into the same clan and returning students are always part of their original clan.

Clans are the heart and soul of healthy competition and good sportsmanship. During the three weeks, clans compete in a variety of Evening Programmes (Dodgeball, Urban Orienteering, Mini Olympics and more) where points are awarded. In the final week the clan games culminate in the ISSOS Highland Games.

The clans are an important part of ISSOS and foster team work, bonding and teach leadership skills while building confidence in every student.

Teachers and Counselors

At ISSOS we pride ourselves on a professional, highly qualified and motivated staff. All of our teachers have been carefully selected from academic institutions around the world for their qualifications, expertise and experience. There is a staff:student ratio of 1:5 and we aim to provide as much individual attention as possible, by limiting students coming from one nationality to 10% we are also able to guarantee a truly international experience. 
ISSOS Students

Bedrooms


