*MPW is one of the UK's leading names in fifth- and sixth-form education, offering a distinctive alternative to traditional schools.*

Founded in 1973, its colleges in London, Birmingham and Cambridge offer the same broad, highly flexible curriculum. We offer a unique teaching approach focused on exam preparation and outstanding personal support.

This approach is reflected in a highly consistent record of exam results; in 2024, the most commonly achieved A level result was A\*/A. Over the past two years, well over 500 MPW students have progressed to Russell Group and University of London universities.




# London




# Programme Overview







### Building Bridges


#### Negotiation and Conflict Resolution for Young Leaders
